## FEMA & SBA DISASTER ASSISTANCE

You can apply online at <https://www.disasterassistance.gov> or in person at a local FEMA Disaster Recovery Center. Locations can be found at <https://www.fema.gov/disaster-recovery-centers>.

If your home was impacted by Hurricane Harvey, you may qualify for a loan from the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA). Loans up to \$200,000 are available to make repairs and up to \$40,000 is available to replace contents destroyed by storm-related causes. A FEMA inspection is required to become eligible for the SBA loan program.

## DISASTER FOOD ASSISTANCE

Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (D-SNAP) offers short-term food assistance benefits to families recovering from a disaster. You must apply in person at your local Texas Health & Human Services office or a designated D-SNAP location in your area.
