PARENTS/ LEGAL GUARDIANS MAY QUALIFY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR CHILD CARE IF THEY:

- Work a minimum of 25 hours each week, go to school full-time or work and go to school combined for at least 25 hours each week.
- Meet the low-income guidelines. For example, a family of four with total household income of \$3,975 or less per month may qualify.
- Reside in one of the following counties: Austin, Brazoria, Chambers, Colorado, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Matagorda, Montgomery, Walker, Waller or Wharton.
