

Harris County Profile

Harris County is located in East Central Texas and is one of 13 counties in the Gulf Coast Region. Harris County's 2013 population estimate was 4,336,853, the largest county in Texas by population. Houston is the county seat. Other towns include Pasadena, Baytown and Bellaire. The Manufacturing, Trade, Service, Local Government, Transportation & Warehousing and Construction Sectors fuel county employment. Harris County is home of Houston, the largest city in Texas, the fourth largest in the nation. The average unemployment rate in Harris County for 2013 was 6.2 percent.

Per Capita Personal Income (2012)

\$52,805 ranking 19th in the State and was 124 percent of the State average, \$42,638. The compound annual growth rate over the past 10 years was 3.9 percent as compared to 3.8 percent for the State and 3.2 percent for the nation.

Total Personal Income (2012)

\$224,617,980,000, accounting for 20.2 percent of the state total and ranking 1st in the State with a compound annual growth rate over the past 10 years of 5.8 percent as compared to 5.7 percent for the State and 4.1 percent for the nation.

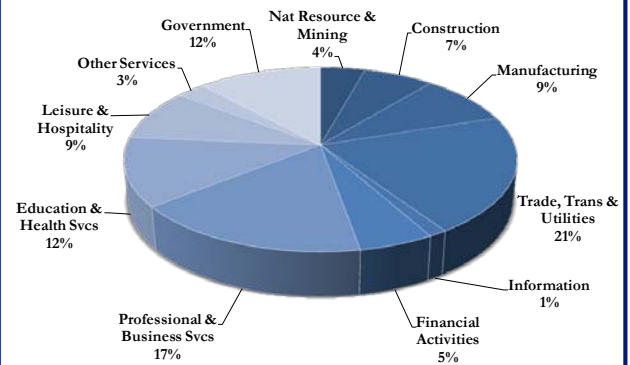

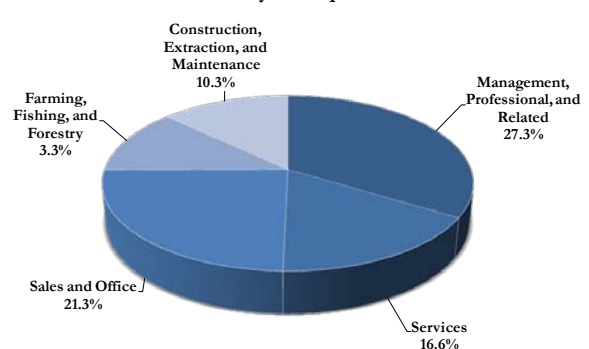
