Climate control systems are found in virtually every home and business, especially here in Texas, where the summers are hot and humid.



This shortage translates into outstanding career opportunities for individuals who are just entering the workforce.

Factors contributing to the shortage:

- The population is growing and new buildings need HVAC systems
- Commercial and residential building owners want to increase efficiency of their existing HVAC systems because of rising energy costs
- Many HVAC mechanics and installers are approaching retirement age
- Not enough young people are encouraged to seek out technical training in the field







HOW DO YOU BECOME AN HVAC MECHANIC AND INSTALLER?

HVAC mechanics and installers work both indoors and outdoors. They can be found at construction sites, in homes, and in businesses or factories. The work may be strenuous at times and some people may have to travel to job sites. HVAC mechanics and installers are required to obtain a certification from the Environmental Protection Agency (**www.epa.gov**), and register with the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (**www.license.state.tx.us**). In the Gulf Coast region, there are two options for HVAC mechanic and installer training: (1) Training programs at community colleges; and (2) Training programs at vocational-technical institutes.
