WHAT YOU KNOW THAT EMPLOYERS WANT

- **Installation** — You can pull conduit and read schematics
- **Maintenance** — You know when something is wrong or likely to go wrong, what kind of maintenance is needed, and you can locate the cause of a breakdown and correct the problem.
- **Tools** — You know how to use a wide range of hand and power tools and testing equipment
- **License** — You maintain current electrician's license or identification card to meet governmental regulations
- **Meeting Standards**— You use your judgment to determine whether events or processes comply with laws, regulations, or standards

SKILLS THAT YOU HAVE THAT EMPLOYERS VALUE

- **Troubleshooting** — Determining causes of operating errors and deciding what to do about it
- **Repairing** — Repairing machines or systems using the needed tools.
- **Complex Problem Solving** — Identifying complex problems and reviewing related information to develop and evaluate options and implement solutions
- **Critical Thinking** — Using logic and reasoning to identify the strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions, conclusions or approaches to problems
