FEBRUARY Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 184,582 people looking for a new job
- DOWN from a peak of 14.3% in April 2020
- **DOWN** from 5.5% last month
- **DOWN** from 7.6% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 4.7%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 4.1%

Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 45,500 jobs in February 2022

- Largest ever gain in the month of February
- Top-3 Drivers of month-to-month Job Growth in February:
 - Professional and Business Services: +10,400
 - Leisure and Hospitality: +9,900
 - o Government: +7,300

Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was UP 6.5%

- This represents 193,000 jobs added over the year
- Currently 11 out of 11 sectors show growth year-to-year

COVID-19

• Employment remains about 62,200 jobs, or 1.9% below February 2020 pre-pandemic levels
