








Gulf Coast Region - Initial UI Claims Historical Estimates and Actual June 1990 to June 2020 (monthly averages)









Gulf Coast WDA WARN Notice Total Reported Layoffs by Month June 2011 to July 2020





*Note: due to a mass expiration of job ads at the end May and the removal of active yet under-viewed ads, total job ads peaked on 5/28 resulting in an - 18% decline over the following 20 days. This phenomenon was first observed in the 6/7 update of this report and with the exception of an increase between 6/10 - 6/13, the current data marks a second instance confirming a negative change in trend.



Change in Job Ads by Occupation























13-County Gulf Coast Region Cities Over-the-month Change in Unemployment Rate (NSA) Apr 2020 to May 2020

























































13-County Gulf Coast Region Over-the-month Change in Unemployment Rate (NSA) Apr 2020 to May 2020





