


Initial Claims for Unemployment Insurance





Gulf Coast Region - Initial UI Claims Historical Estimates and Actual June 1990 to June 2020 (monthly averages)





Gulf Coast Region - Continuing UI Claims Historical Estimates and Actual May 1990 to May 2020 (monthly averages)





This phenomenon was first documented in the 6/7 update of this report and has failed to reverse since that time suggesting it remains a significant event. Note that impacts on 7-day over 7-day trends are no longer a concern however the event now falls within 30-day over 30-day trends and as a result trends within this timeframe should be viewed with caution.





Change in Job Ads by Occupation





















13-County Gulf Coast Region Over-the-month Change in Unemployment Rate (NSA) Apr 2020 to May 2020





