Other towns include The Woodlands, Montgomery and New Caney. The Trade, Services, Manufacturing and Local Government Sectors fuel county employment. Montgomery County is home to Lake Conroe, a popular recreation area for Houston residents that are less than an hour away. The average unemployment rate in Montgomery County for 2019 was 3.4 percent.




