


#### Initial Claims for Unemployment Insurance





Gulf Coast Region - Initial UI Claims Historical Estimates and Actual June 1990 to June 2020 (monthly averages)









Gulf Coast WDA WARN Notice Total Reported Layoffs by Month Sept 2017 to Sept 2020

























13-County Gulf Coast Region Over-the-month Change in Unemployment Rate (NSA) May 2020 to Jun 2020





