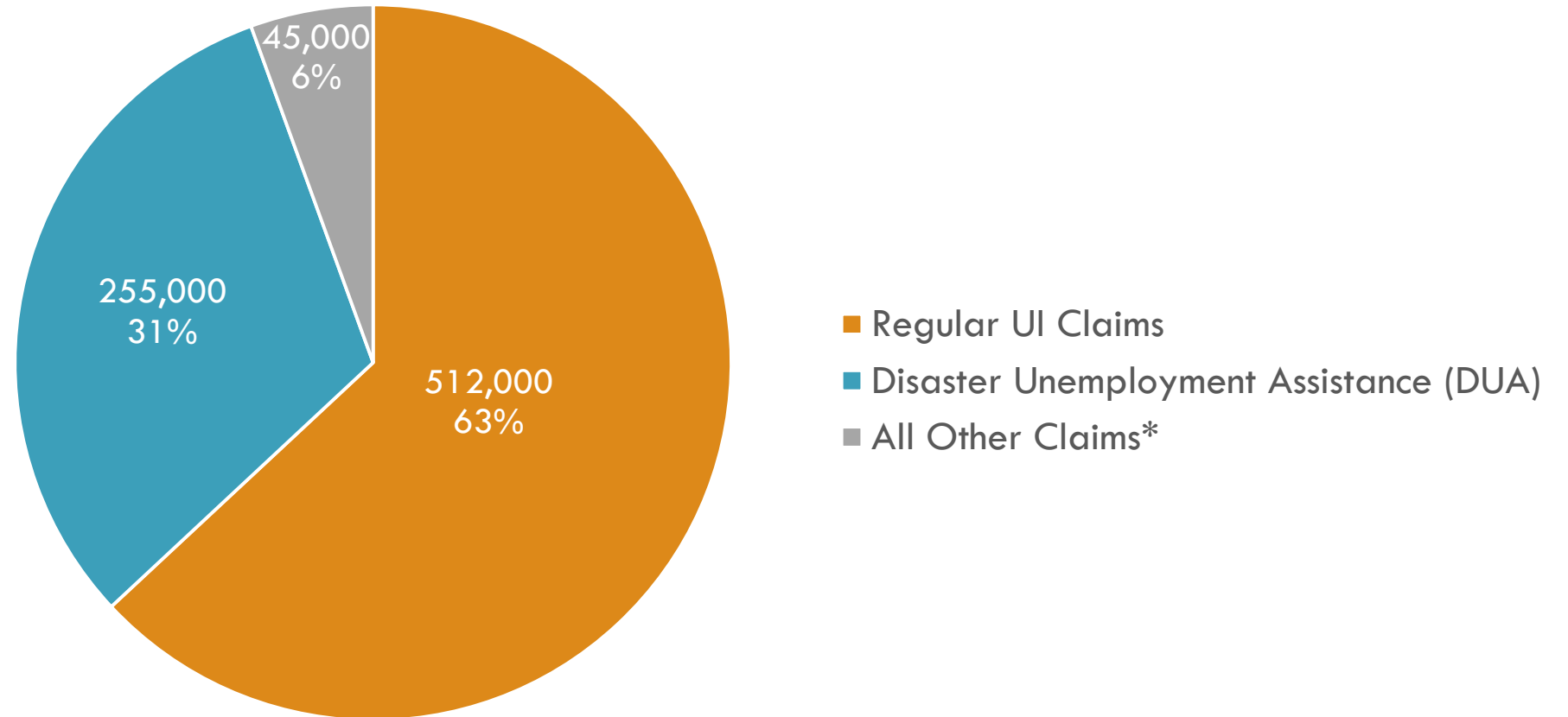

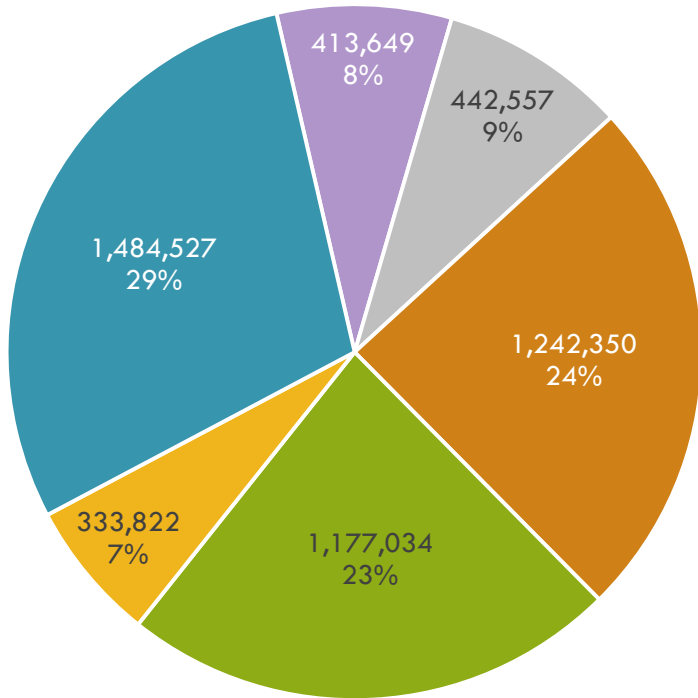

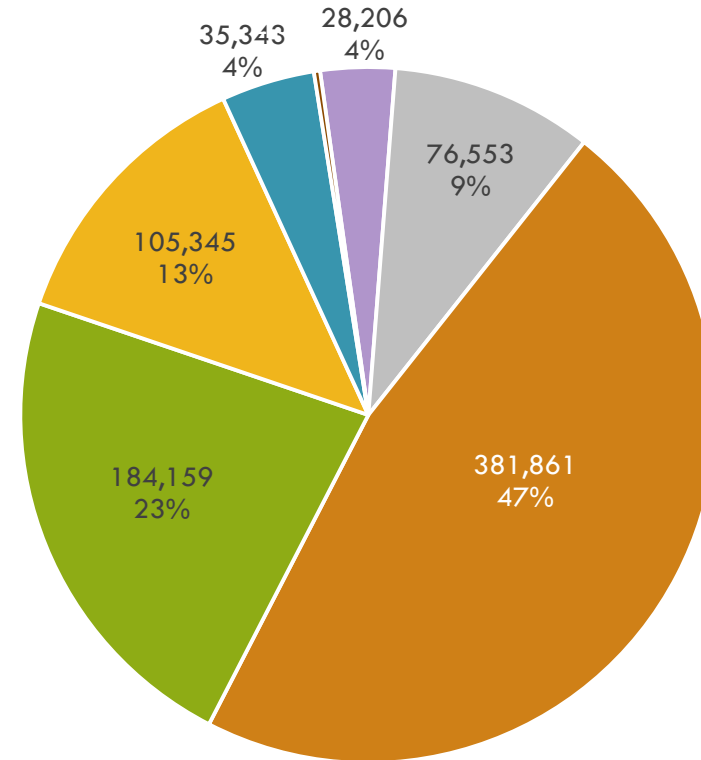
Gulf Coast Region Total Population vs. UI Claimants by Ed. Attainment



Gulf Coast Population Age by Ed. Attainment (ACS 2018)

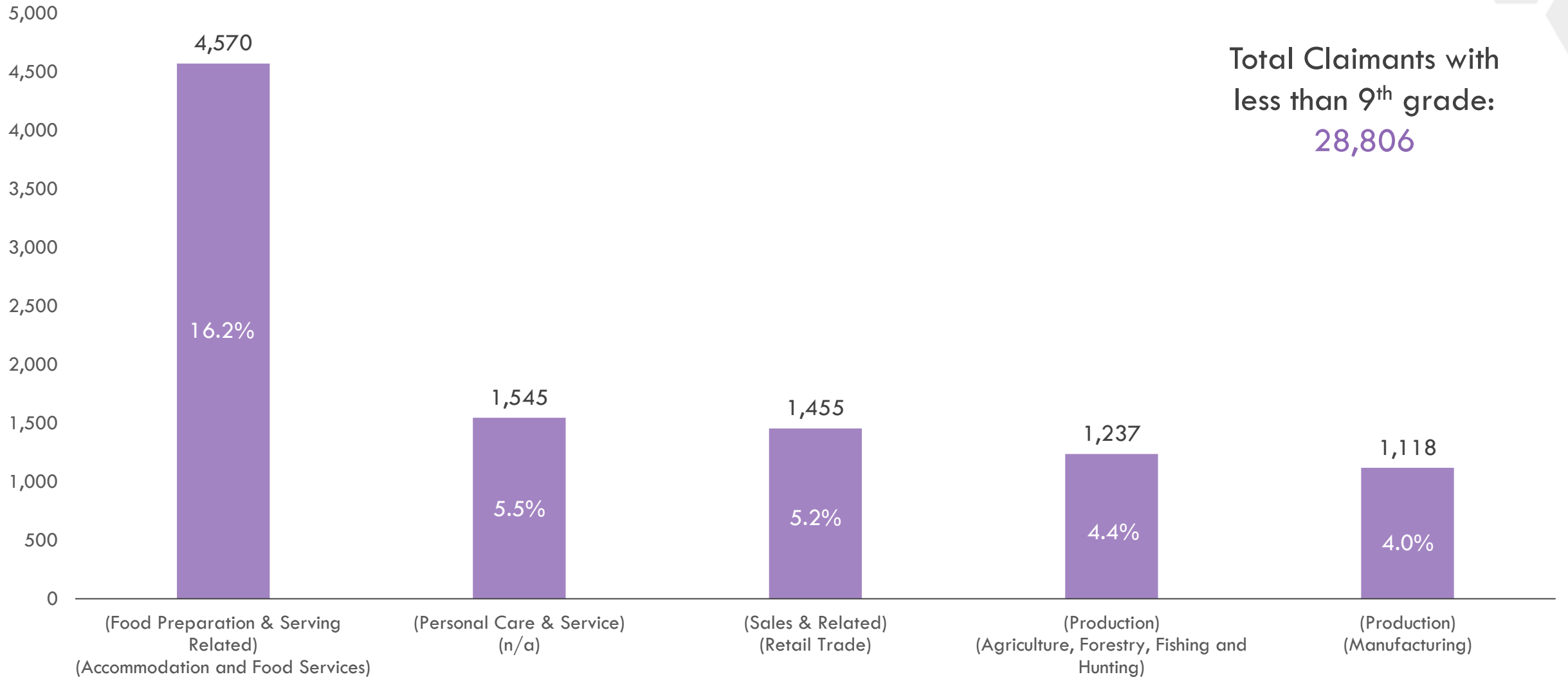


Gulf Coast UI Claimants by Ed. Attainment (TWC 3/1 to 7/18 2020)

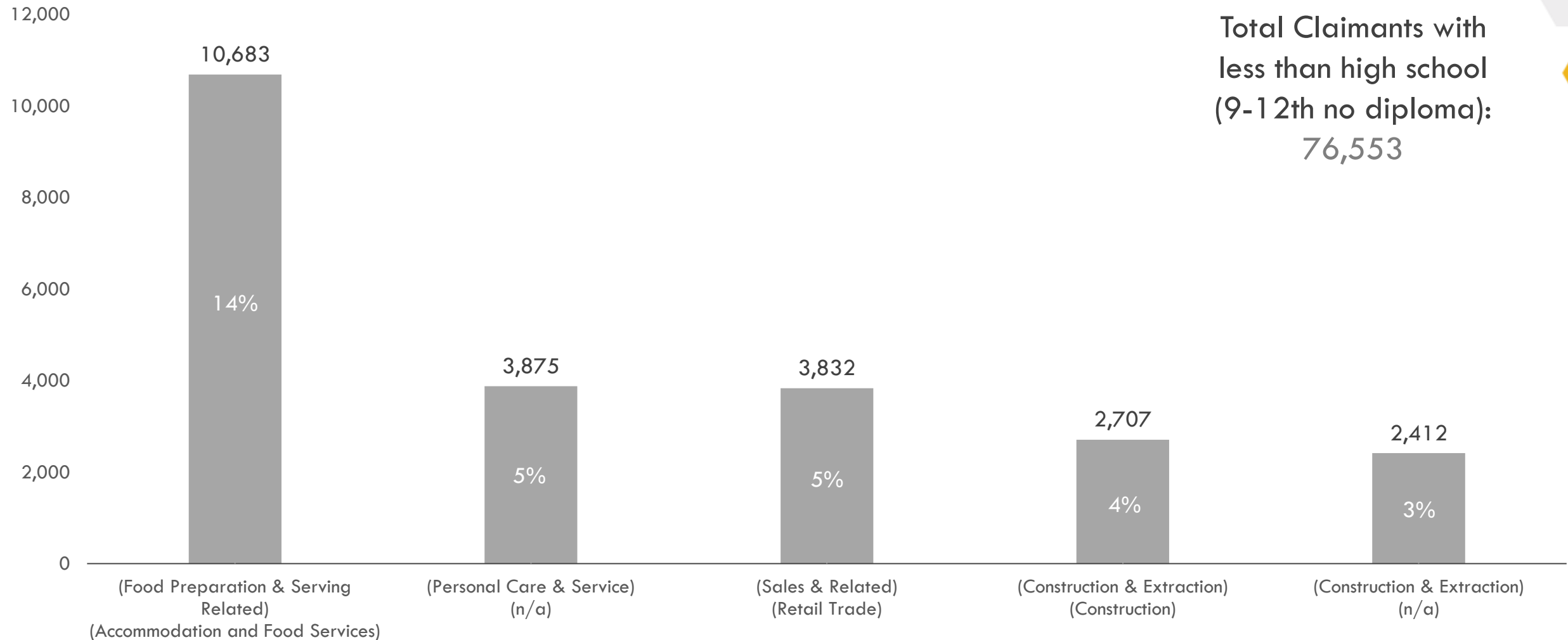

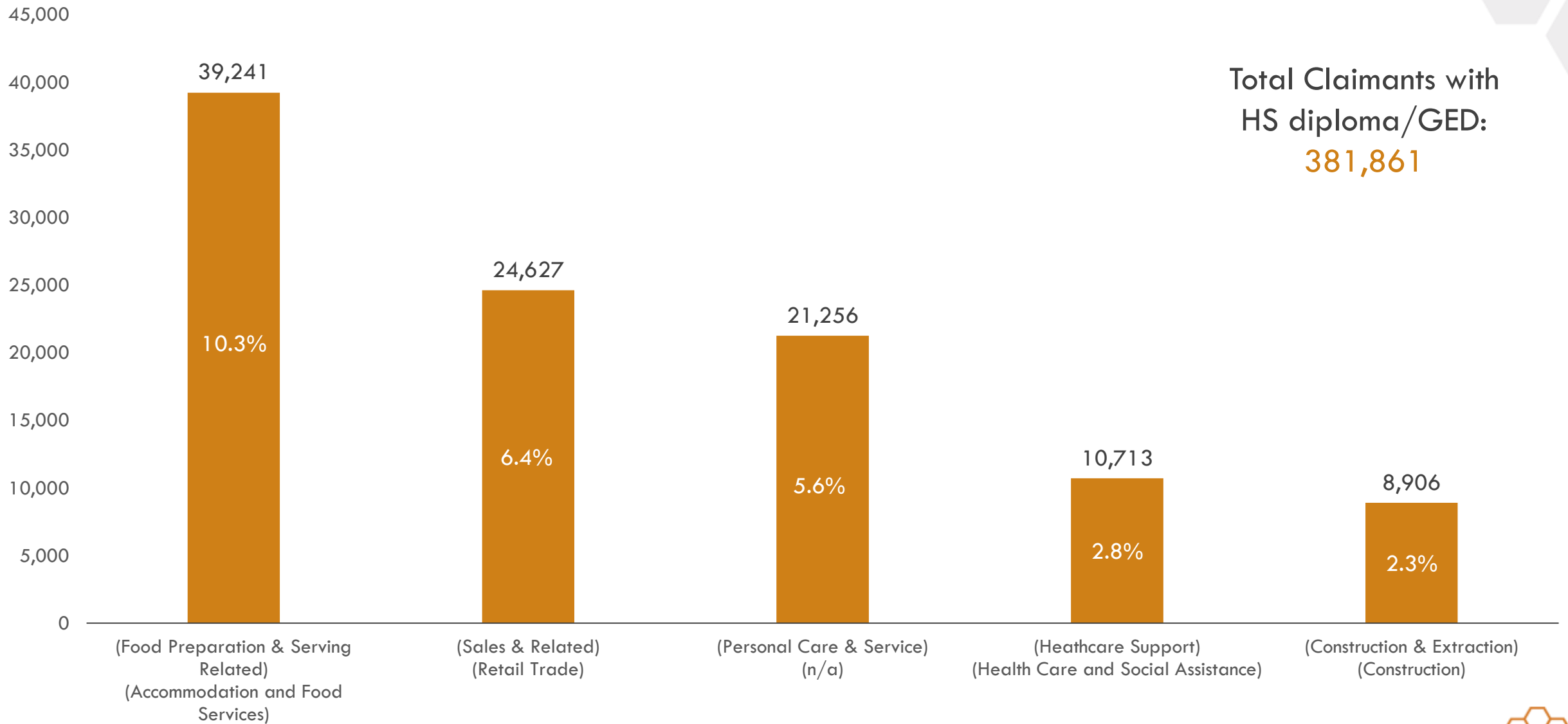

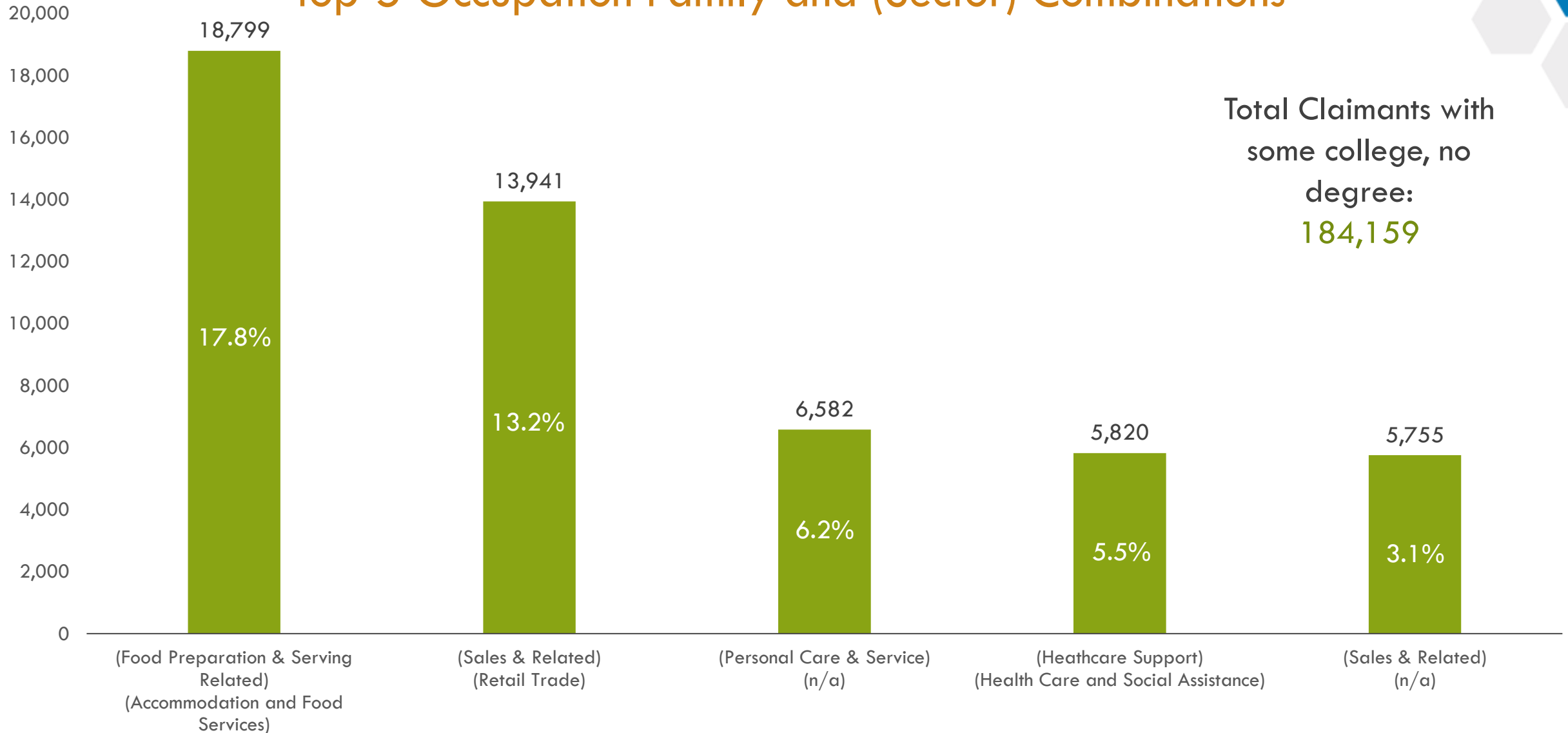


Gulf Coast Region UI Claimants with High School Diploma/GED

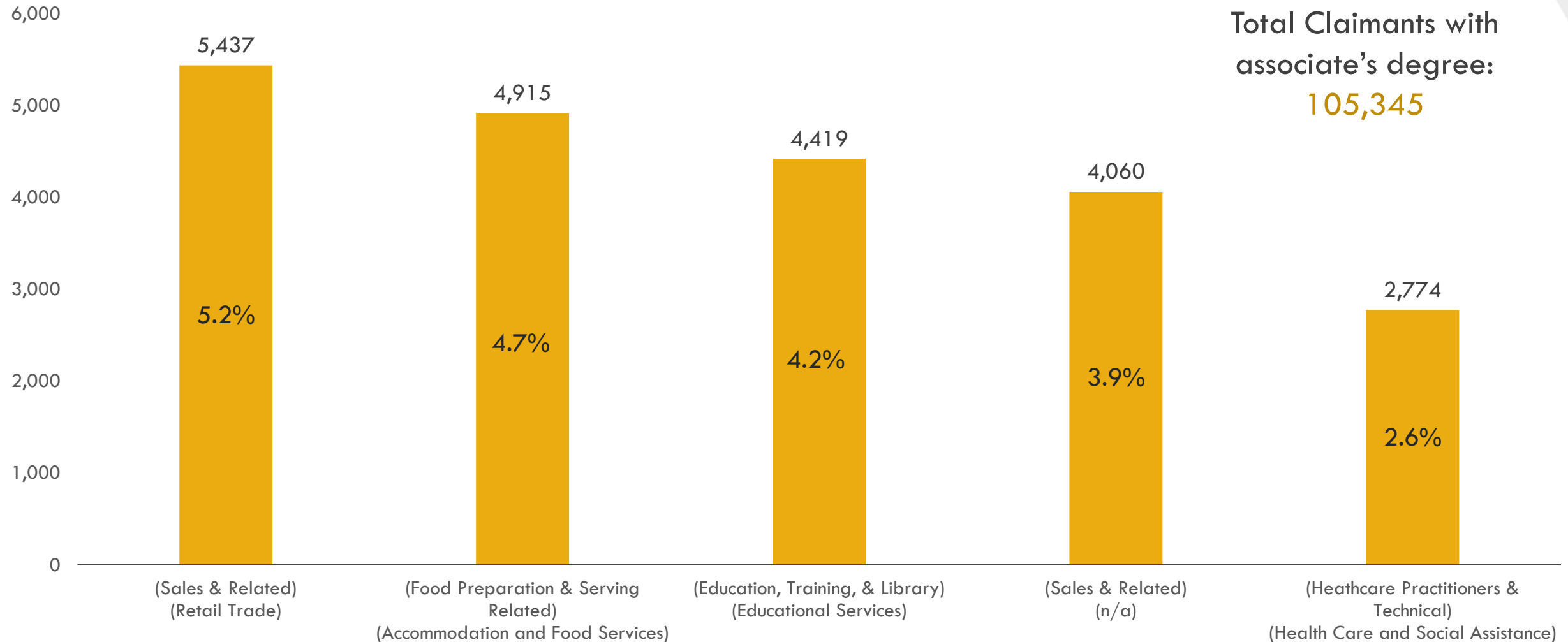
Top-5 (Occupation Family) and (Sector) Combinations – Incl. Share of Claims



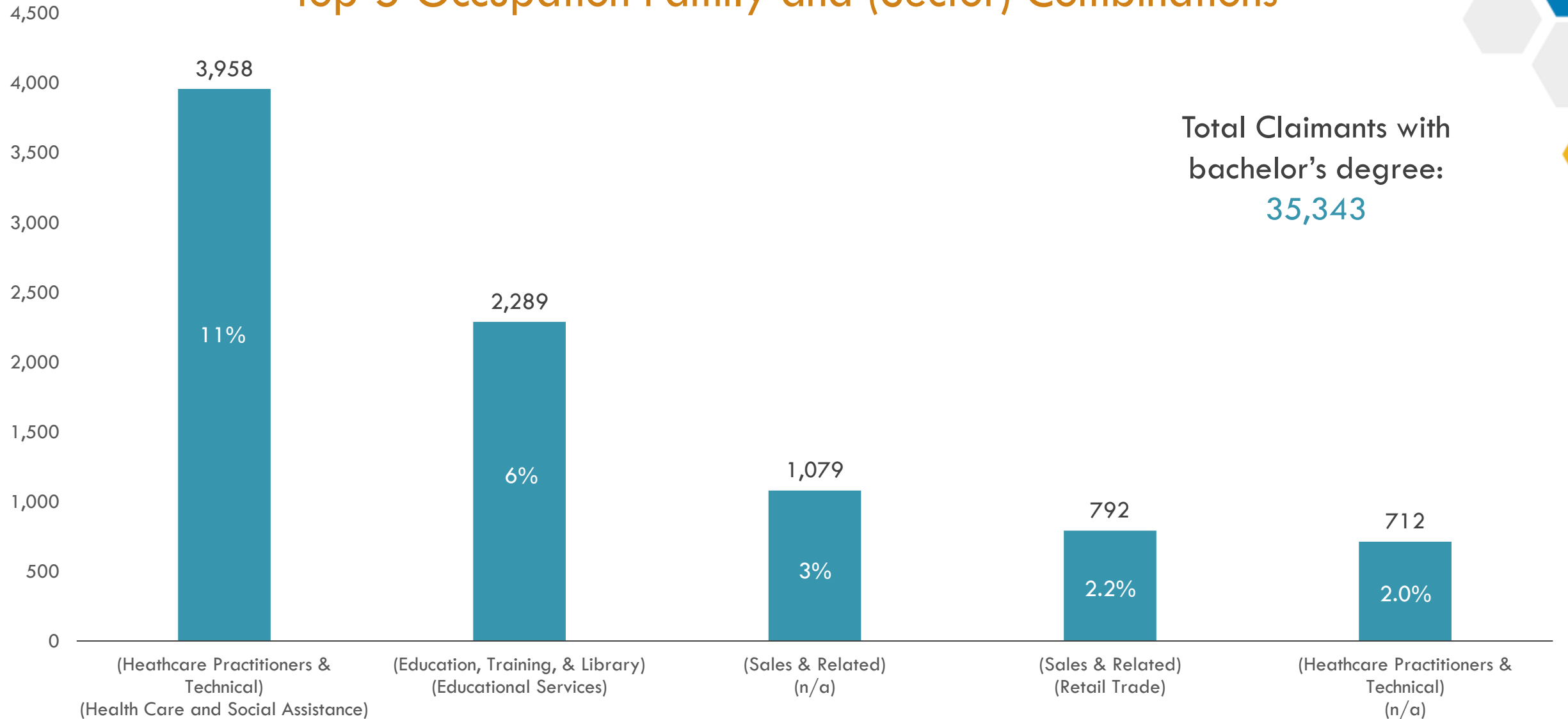
Gulf Coast Region UI Claimants with Some College No Degree Top-5 Occupation Family and (Sector) Combinations



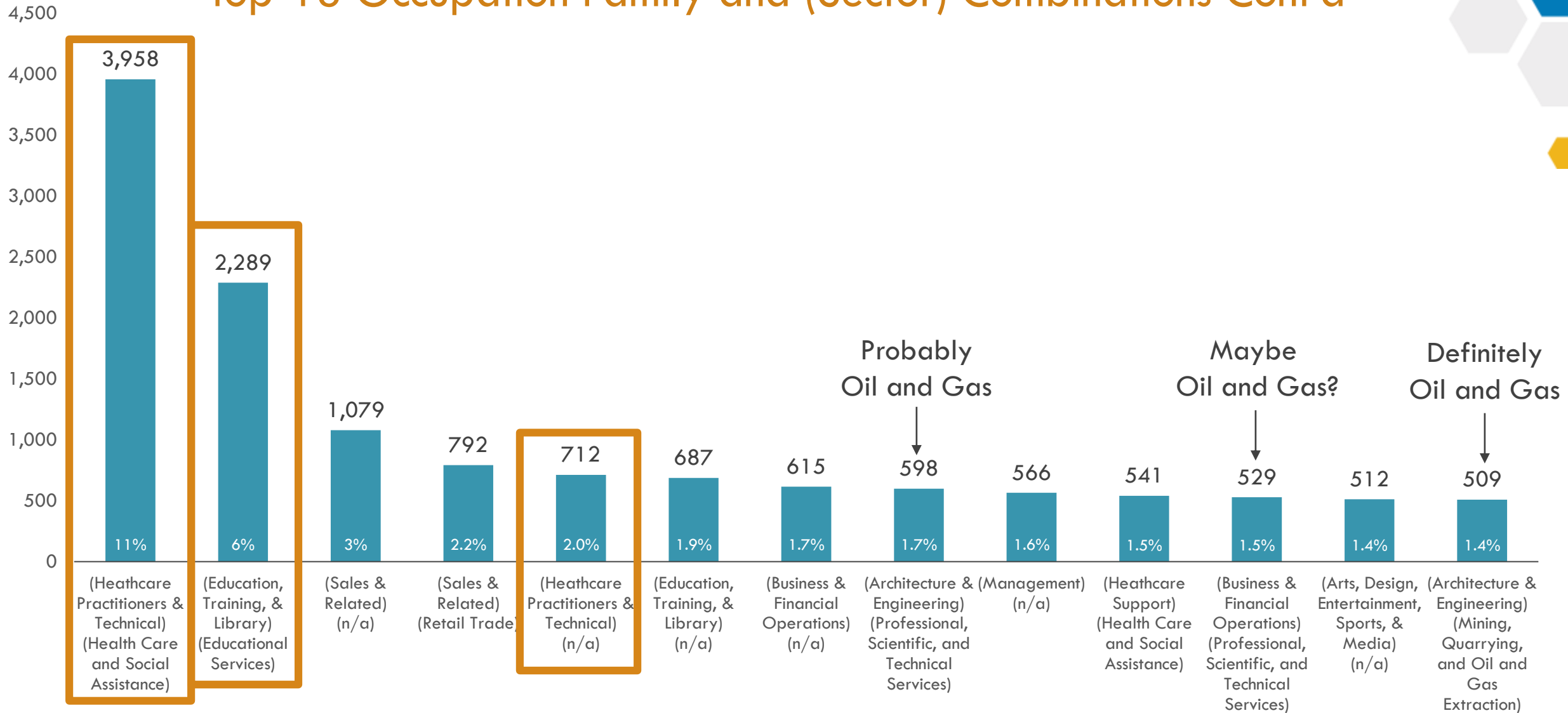
Gulf Coast Region UI Claimants with Associate's Degree Top-5 (Occupation Family) and (Sector) Combinations – Incl. Share of Claims



Gulf Coast Region UI Claimants with Bachelor's Degree Top-5 Occupation Family and (Sector) Combinations

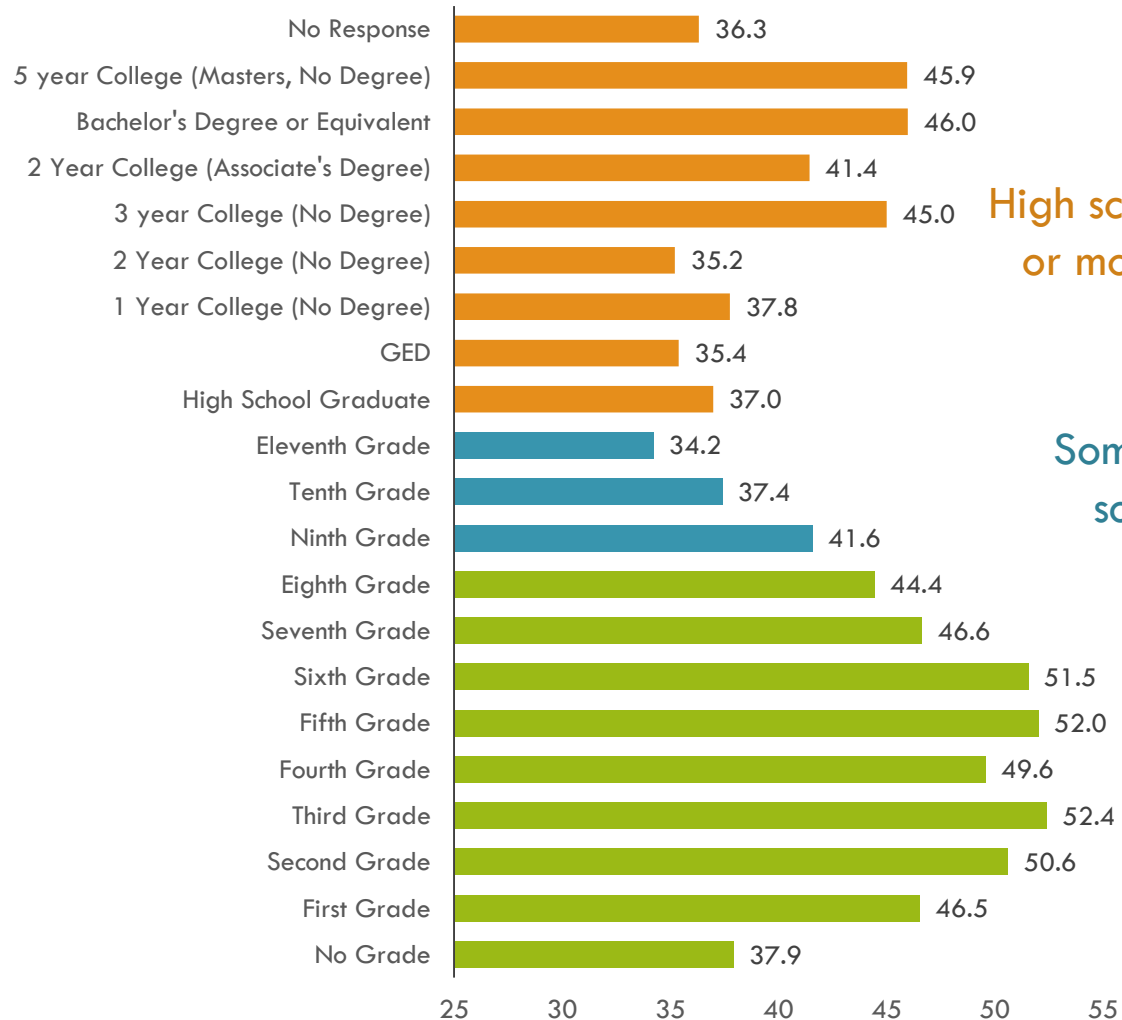

Average (Mean) Age by Ed. Attainment

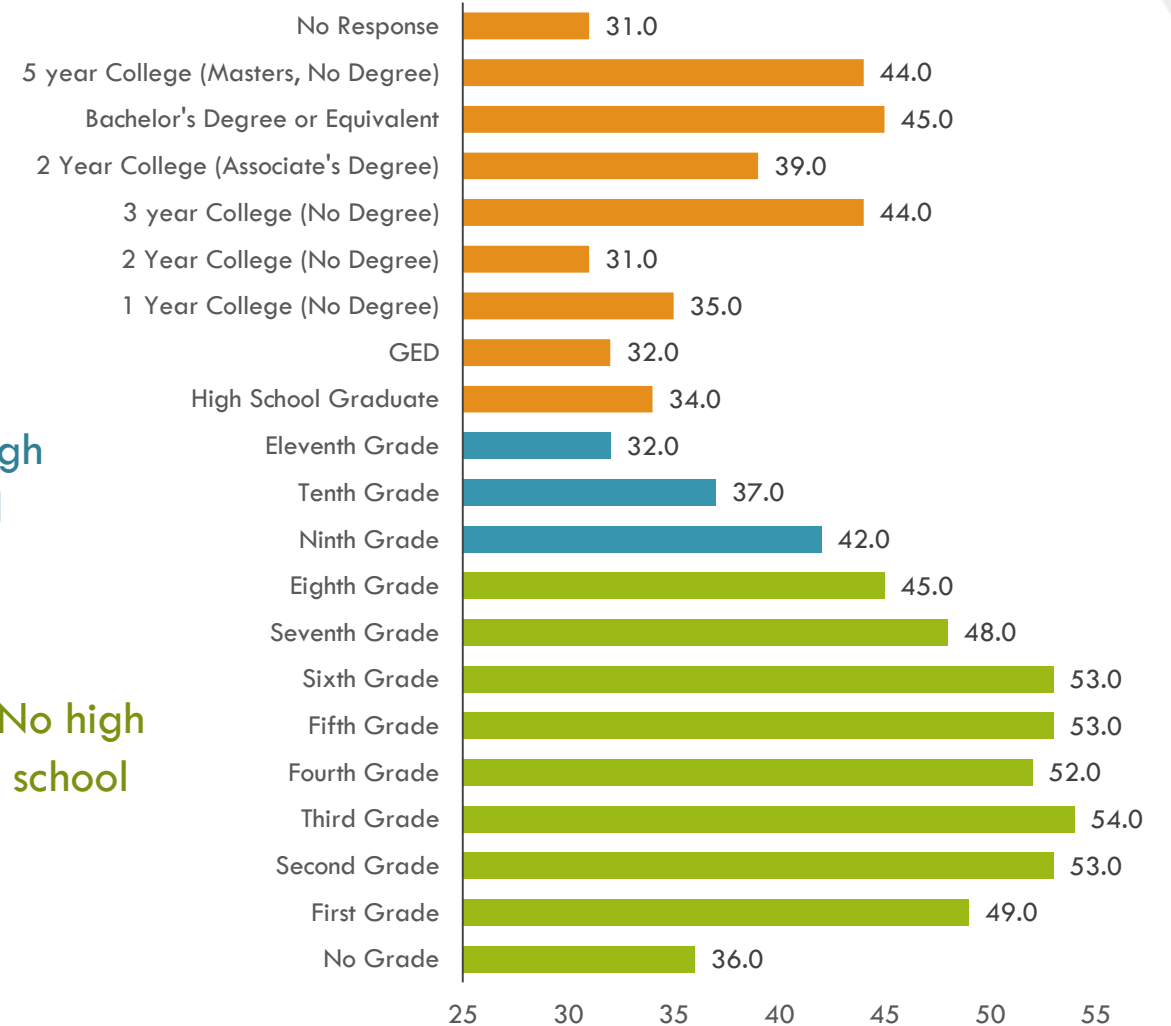

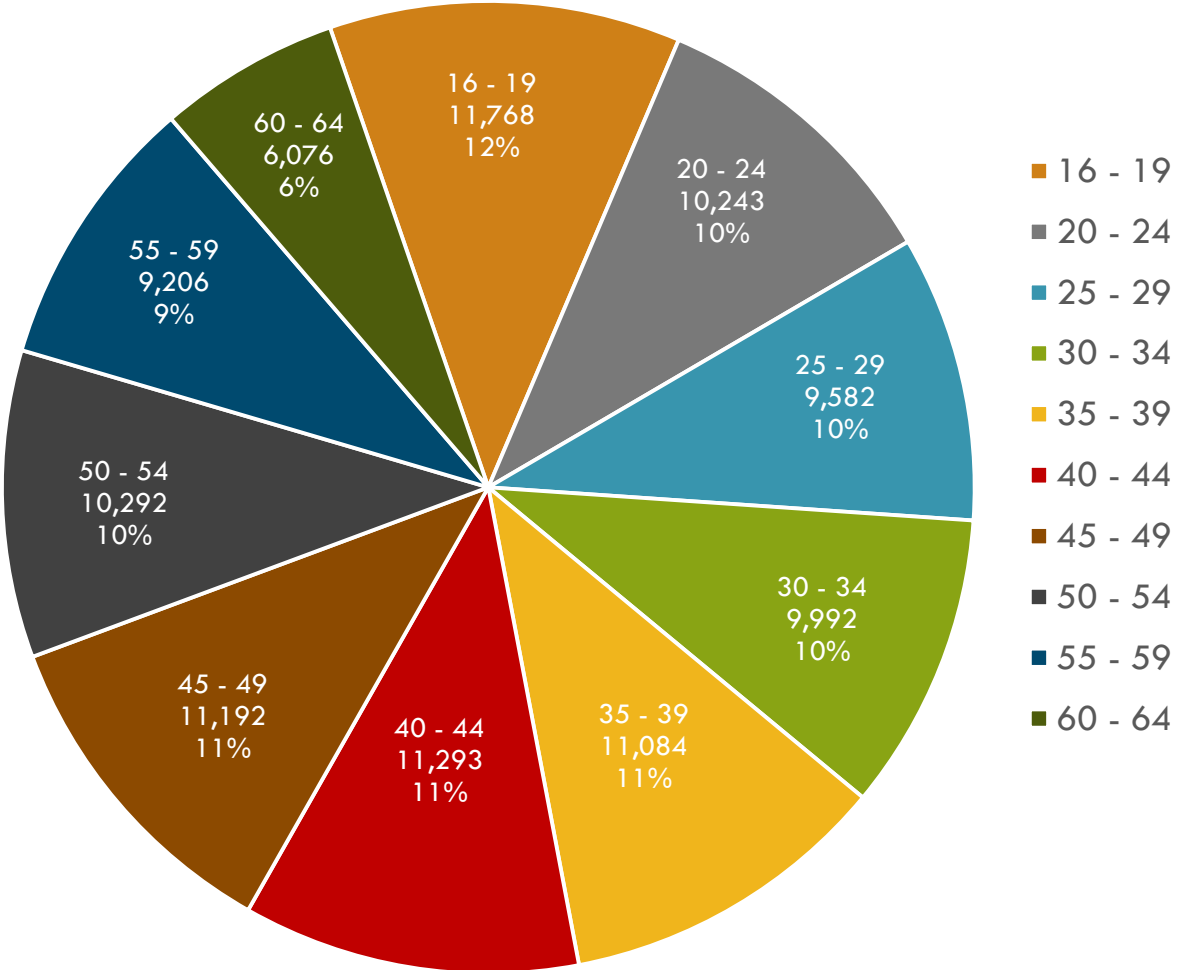

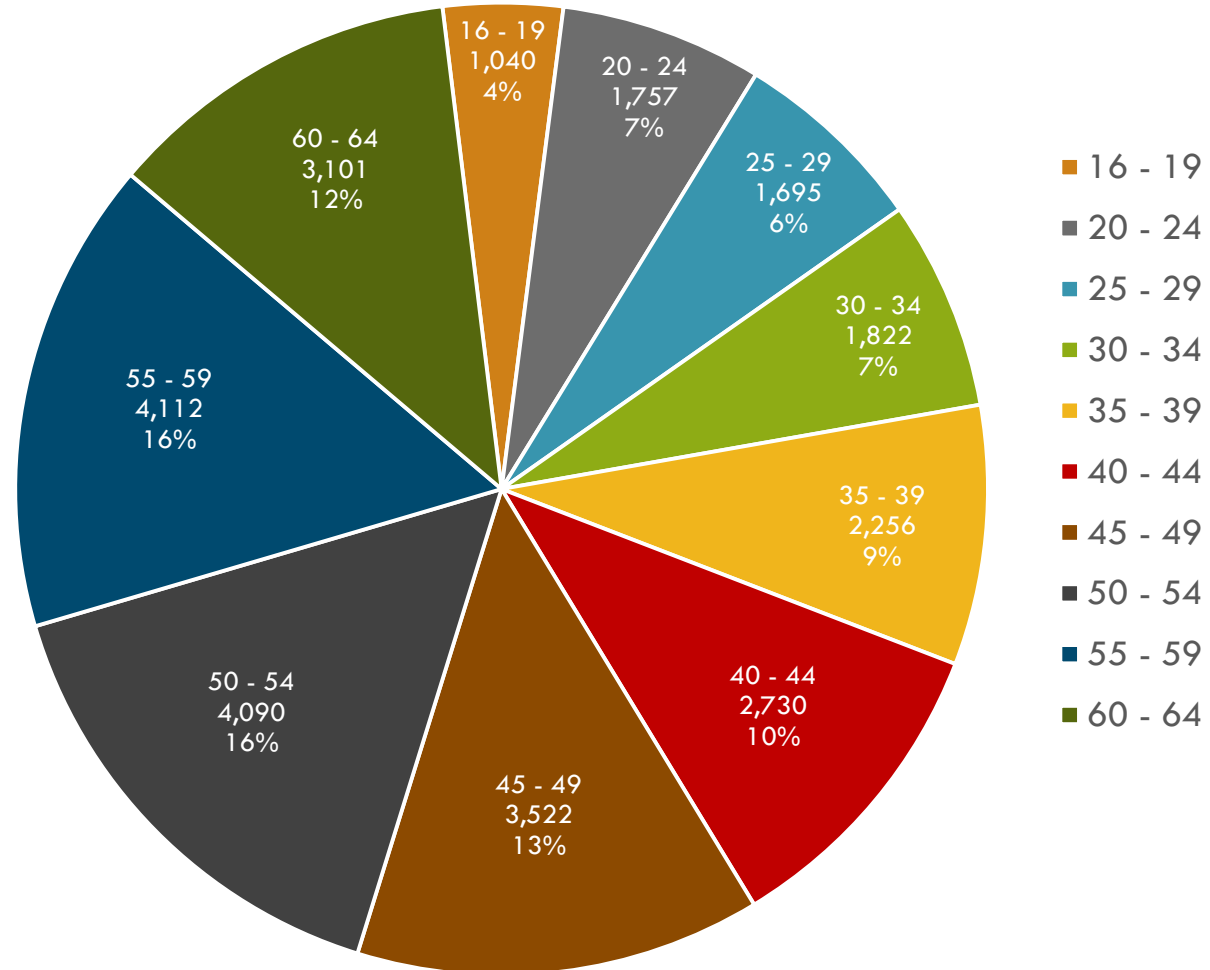

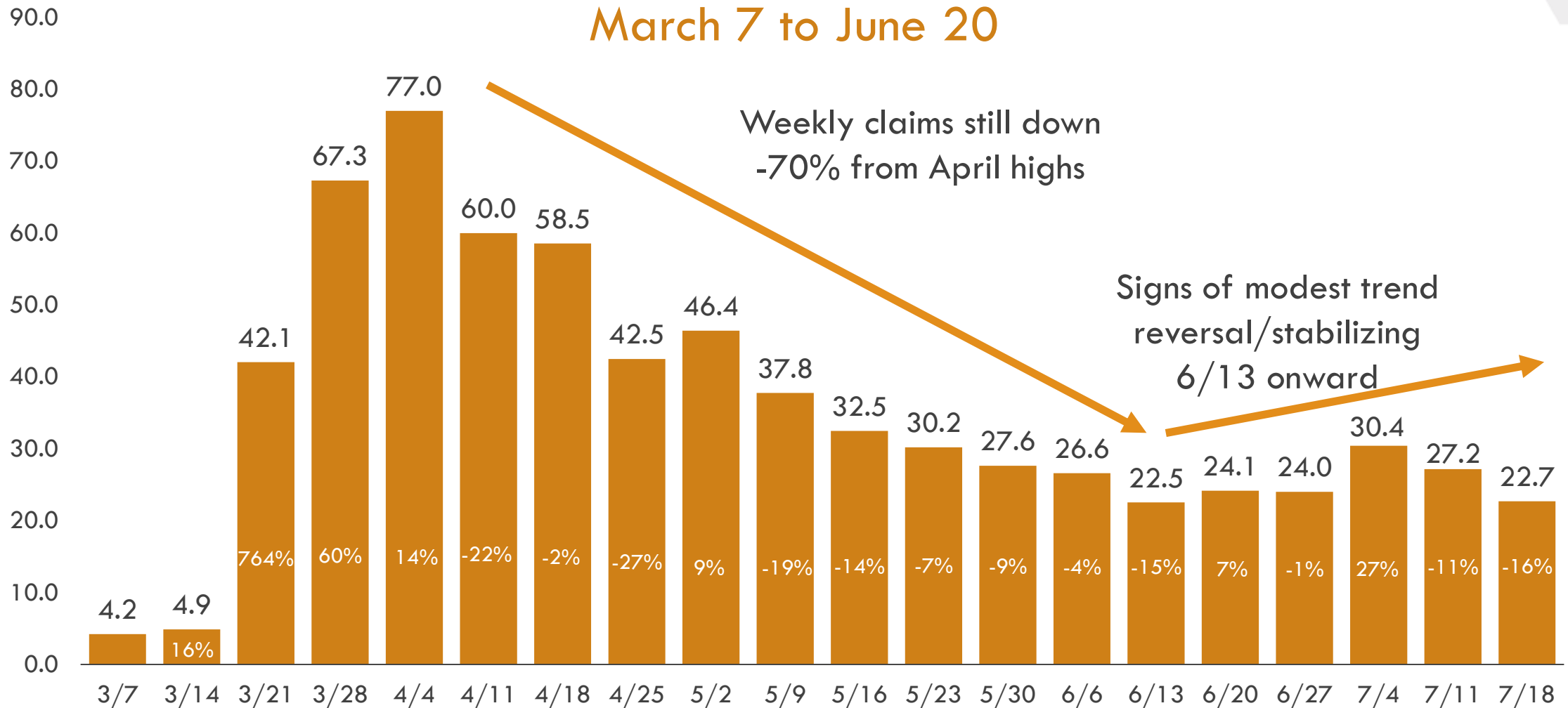
Gulf Coast Region Age Distribution of UI Claimants with 11th Grade Education or Less



Gulf Coast Region Age Distribution of Claimants with 8th Grade Education or Less

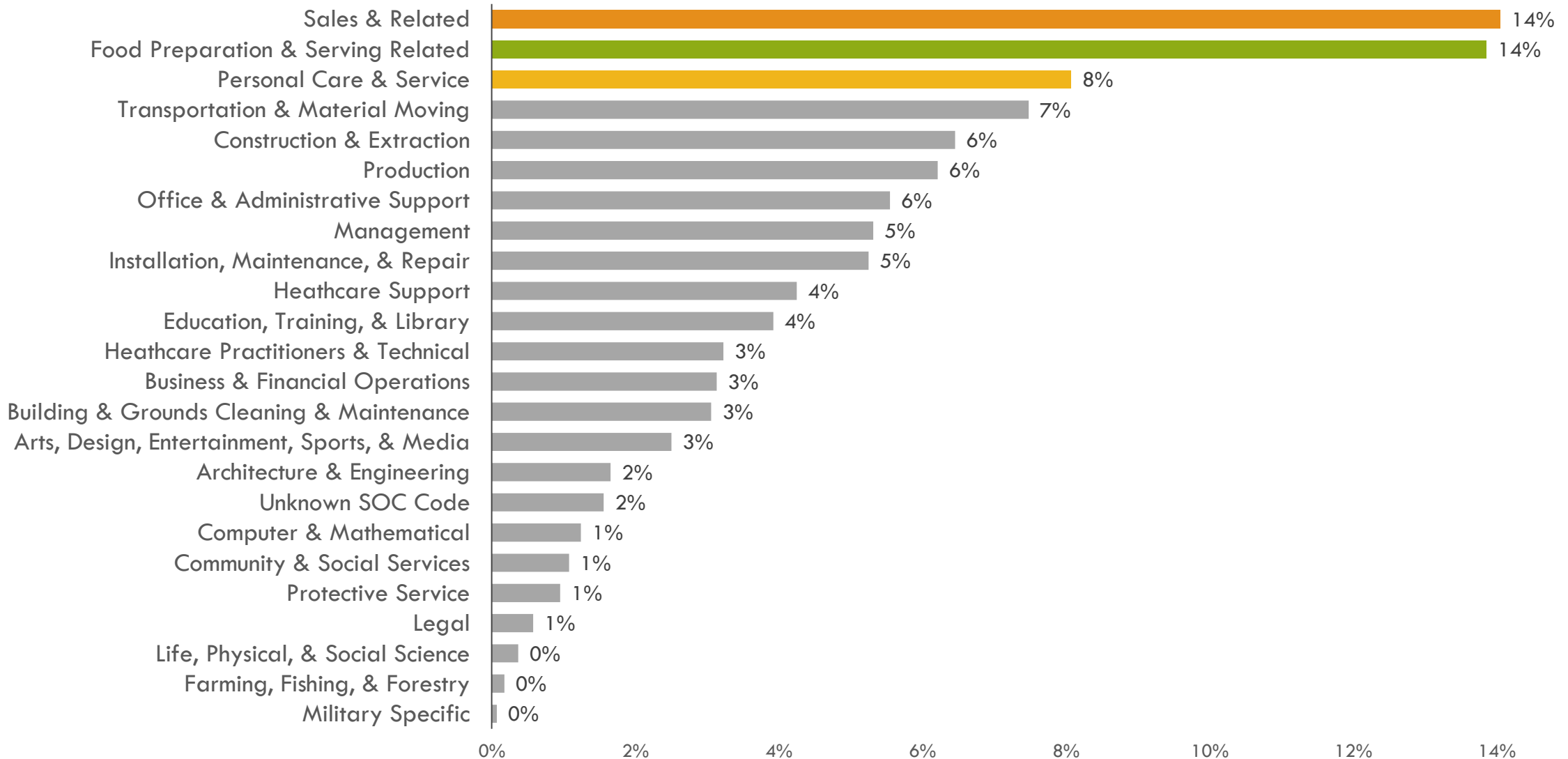


13-County Region Weekly Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims Week and Percent Change from Previous Week March 7 to June 20



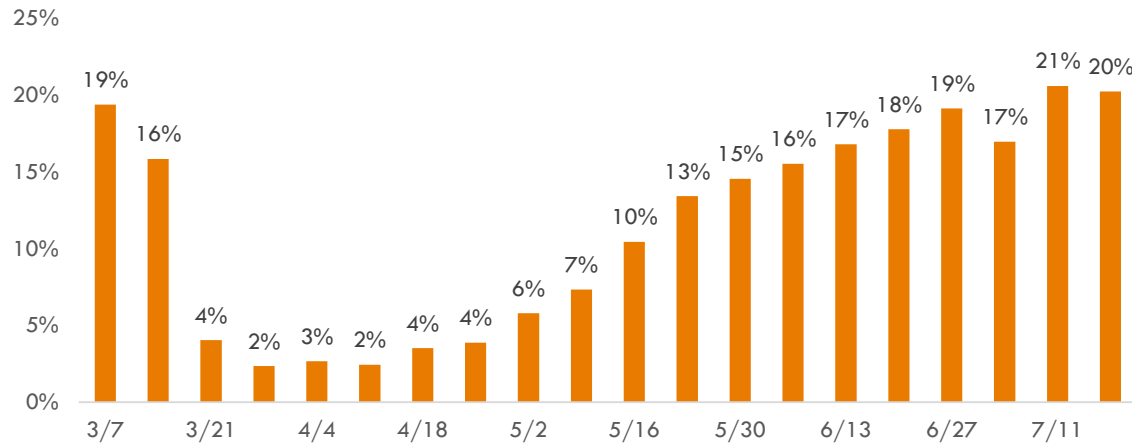

Gulf Coast Region Share of Claims by Major Occupation Family Week of 3/7 to 7/4

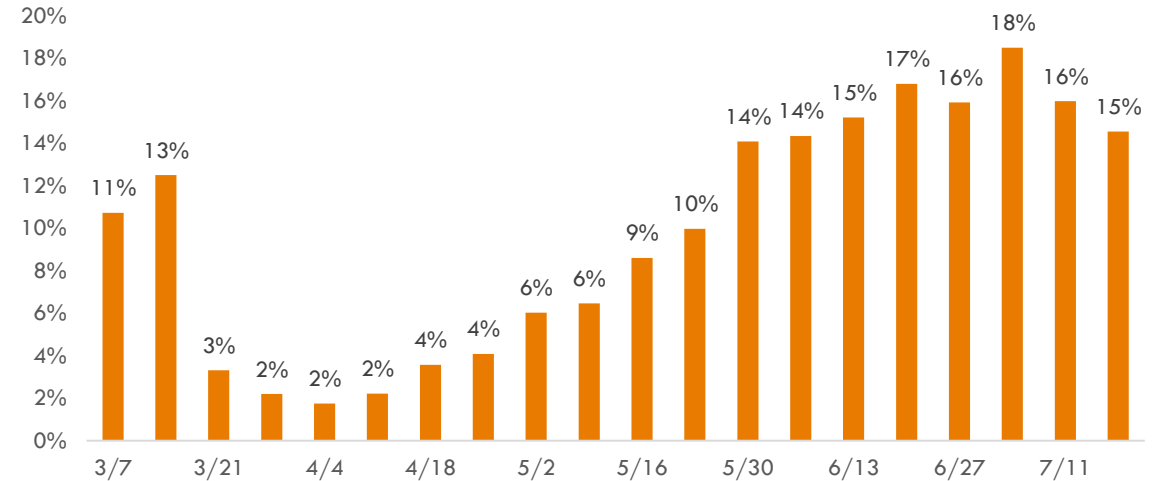


Gulf Coast Region Retail Segments with Increasing Share of Total Retail Claims

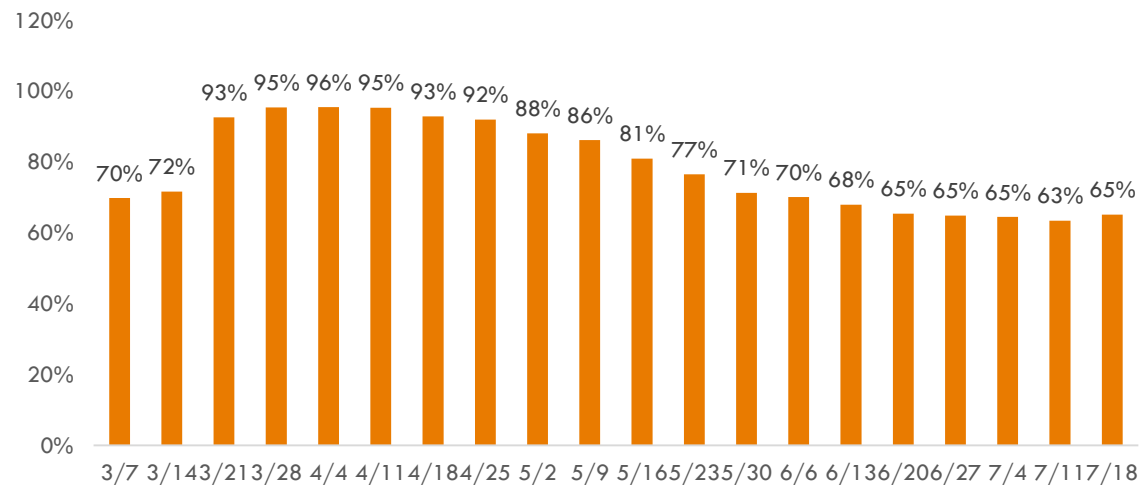

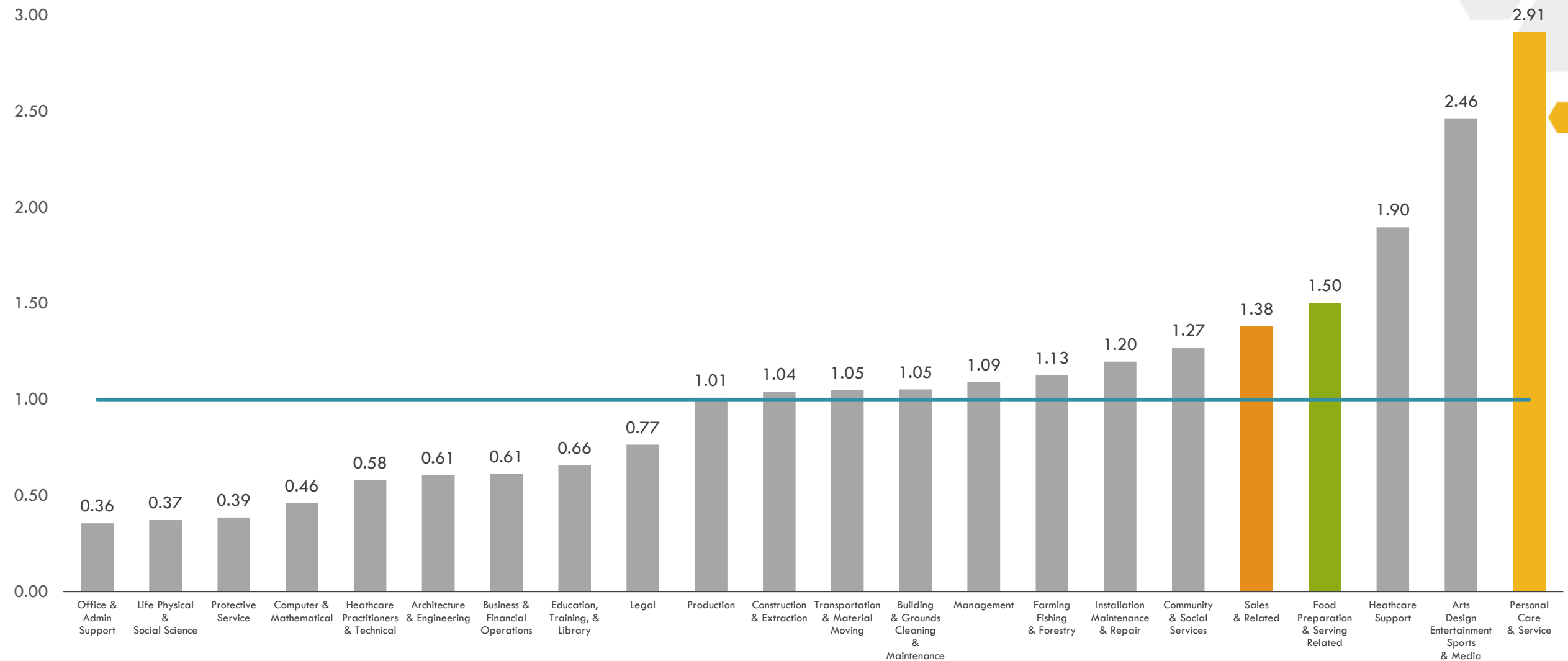

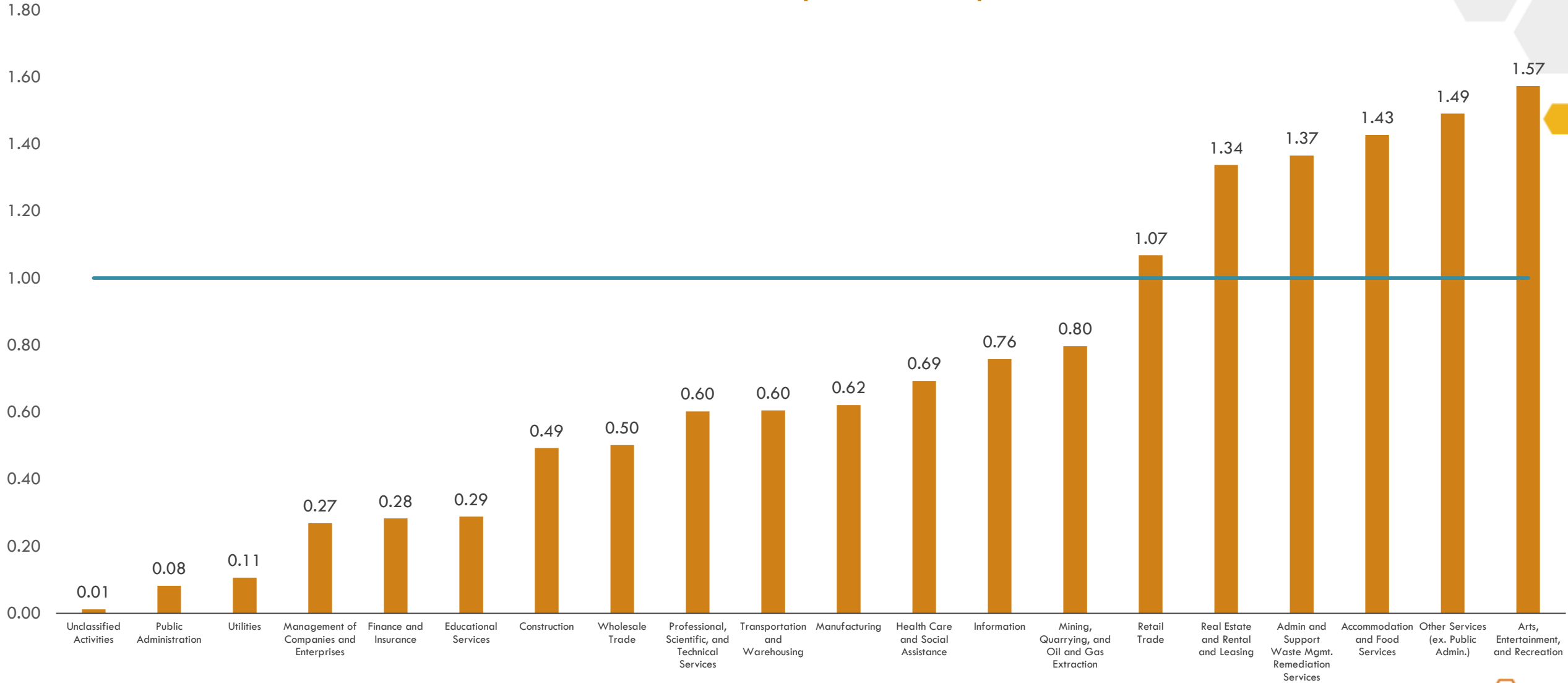
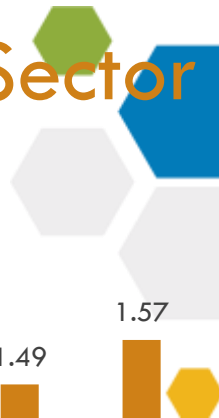


Gulf Coast Over-Under Representation of Claimants by Major Occupation Family Week of 3/7 to 6/28



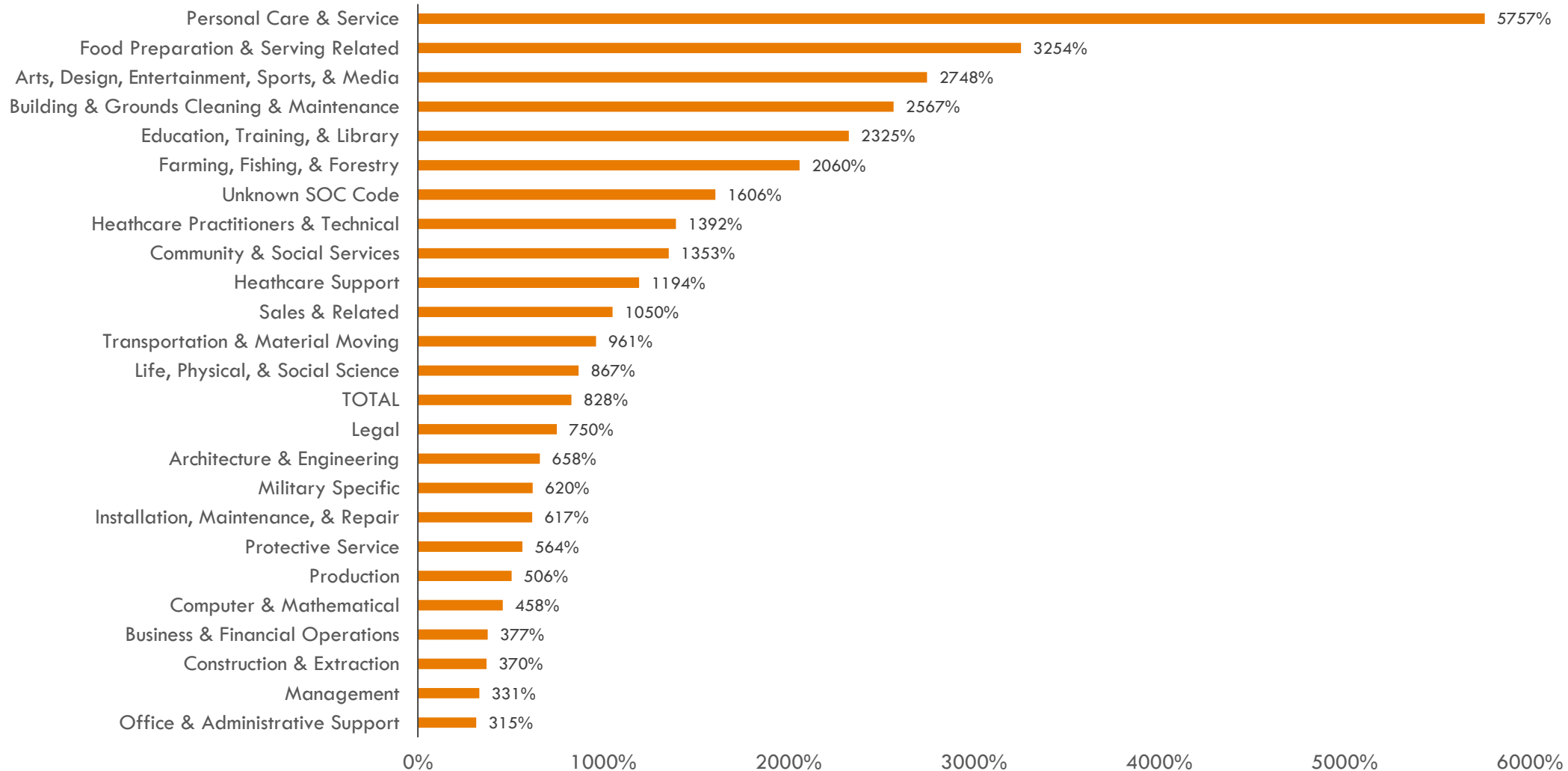
Gulf Coast Over-Under Representation of Claimants by Major Sector

Week of 3/7 to 7/4



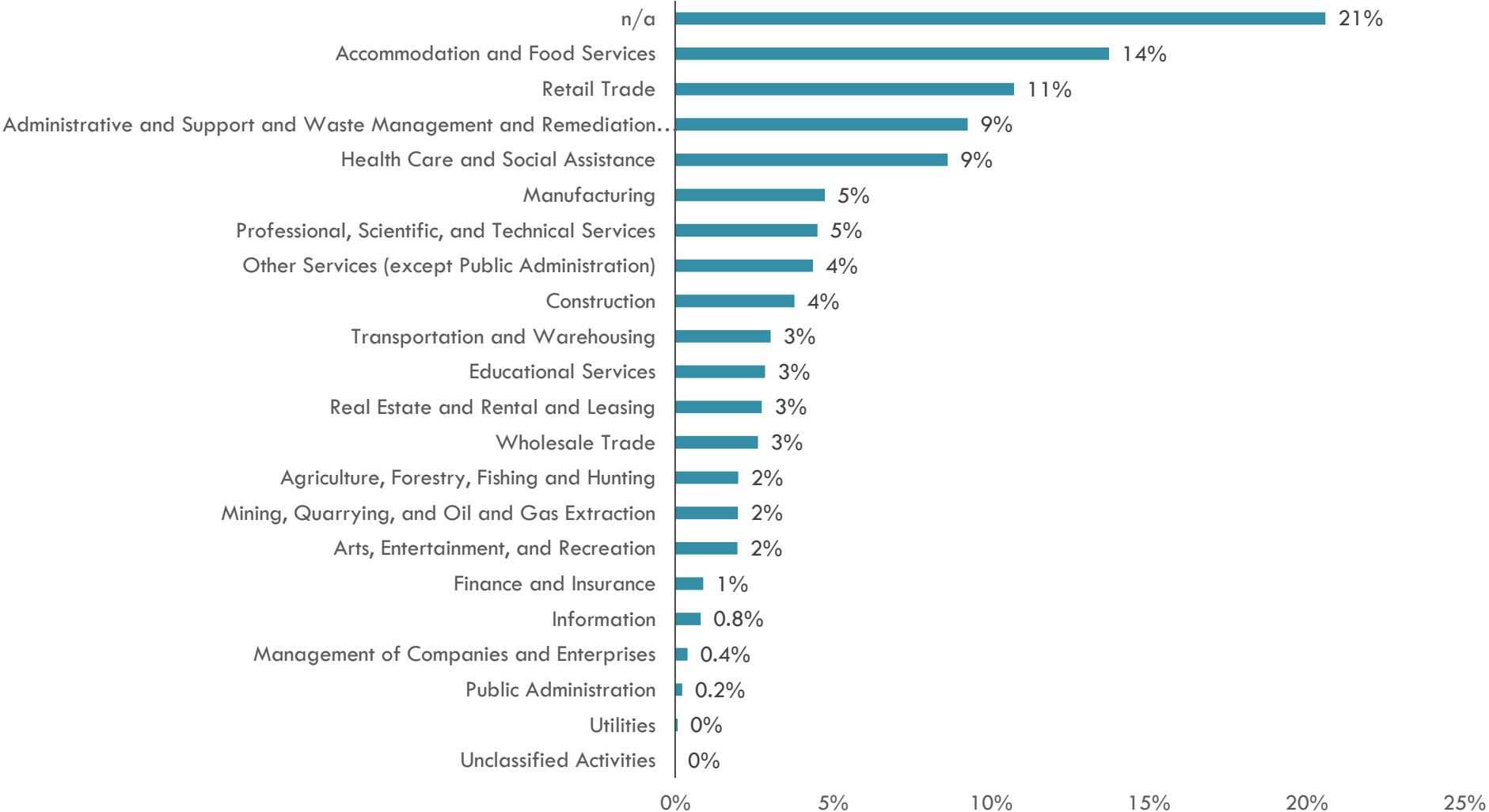
Gulf Coast Region Percent Change in Claims by Occupation Family
