Chambers County Profile

Chambers County is located in East Central Texas and is one of 13 counties in the Gulf Coast Region. Chambers County's 2012 population estimate was 36,196. Anahuac is the county seat. Other towns include Winnie, Mont Belview, and Stowell. The Manufacturing, Trade, Service, and Local Government Sectors fuel county employment. Chambers County is the home of the Texas Rice Festival, Texas Gatorfest in September. The average unemployment rate in Chambers County for 2013 was 7.0 percent.

\$51,897 ranking 22^{nd} in the State and was 122 percent of the State average, \$42,638. The compound annual growth rate over the past 10 years was 6.4 percent as compared to 3.8 percent for the State and 3.2 percent for the nation.




