

Galveston County is located in East Central Texas and is one of 13 counties in the Gulf Coast Region. Galveston County's 2013 population estimate was 306,782. Galveston is the county seat. Other towns include Texas City, Bacliff and Friendswood. The Trade, Service, State and Local Government Sectors fuel county employment. Galveston County is best known for Galveston Island, a popular recreational and summer vacation spot. The average unemployment rate in Galveston County for 2013 was 6.8 percent.

Per Capita Personal Income (2012)

\$45,443 ranking 50th in the State and was 107 percent of the State average, \$42,638. The compound annual growth rate over the past 10 years was 3.9 percent as compared to 3.8 percent for the State and 3.2 percent for the nation.

Total Personal Income (2012)

\$13,651,835,000 ranking 14^{th} in the State with a compound annual growth rate over the past 10 years of 5.4 percent as compared to 5.7 percent for the State and 4.1 percent for the nation.




