Matagorda County is located in East Central Texas and is one of 13 counties in the Gulf Coast Region. Matagorda County's 2013 population estimate was 36,592. Bay City is the county seat. Other towns include Palacios and Blessing. The Trade, Services, Construction, and Local Government Sectors fuel county employment. Matagorda County, is home of the South Texas Nuclear Plant and is one of the largest nuclear plants of its kind in the world. The average unemployment rate in Matagorda County for 2013 was 9.6 percent.




