

13-County Region Unemployment Rate




13-County Unemployment Rates & Unemployed Persons (NSA) February vs. March 2020

13-County Unemployment Rate (NSA) 1990-2020










Fort Bend County Unemployment Rates & Unemployed Persons (NSA)
February vs. March 2020






13-County Gulf Coast Region Unemployment Rates March 2020



13-County Gulf Coast Cities Unemployment Rates March 2020






13-County Region Cumulative Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims Week of March 7 to April 25





Recap


- March unemployment rate below average in historical terms but already showing Great Recession-level impacts
- Potential rise in unemployment rate to 10% to 14% in April based on initial Ul claims since early March
- 94,000 active unique job ads in region at present
- Job ads indicate pull-back in hiring across all major sectors with any increases in hiring specific to individual employers
- Increased hiring for occupations limited to media/communications and specialist physicians while IT-related show disproportionate retreat





13-County Gulf Coast Region Daily Active Job Ads March 1st - April 26th 2019 vs. 2020




13-County Gulf Coast Region Unemployment Rates March 2020
