Composite Materials Technicians work to provide materials that offer superior qualities of strength, weight, and flexibility in manufacturing products.

Basic Electrical Technician (161 CH)

Electrical technicians work with electrical engineers using design plans to construct or repair electrical systems. They can detect a potential problem with a design and inspect products to ensure electrical items are assembled properly and will work as expected.
