

On May 21, 2021 the Texas Workforce Commission released employment statistics for **April 2021**. Our detailed regional report for researchers and analysts is at <u>http://www.wrksolutions.com/LocalStats</u>.Below are highlights.

APRIL Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 240,711 people looking for a new job
- DOWN from a peak of 14.3% in April 2020
- **DOWN** from 8.0% last month
- **DOWN** from 14.0% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 6.3%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 5.7%

Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 18,700 jobs in April 2021

Job growth came from the following sectors:

- -Leisure and Hospitality +11,800
- -Professional and Business Services +6,900
- -Other Services +2,500

Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was UP 6.7%

The Houston area has regained roughly 50% of the jobs lost in March and April 2020 due to the pandemic.

Effective June 26, Texans will no longer receive unemployment compensation related to the pandemic, including the additional \$300 weekly supplement
