JANUARY Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 159,198 people looking for a job
- DOWN from a peak of 13.5% in April 2020
- UP from 3.8% last month
- **DOWN** from 4.5% last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 4.1%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 4.1%

Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston region shed 51,100 jobs over the month consistent with January each year.

- The top-3 drivers of over-the-month Job loss this January were:
 - Trade, Transportation, and Utilities: -19,300
 - Professional and Business Services: -10,500
 - Government: -7,100

Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was up 83,300 jobs or 2.5%

- A year prior, growth stood at 175,000; growth is expected to continue slowing to pre-pandemic levels of 60,000 to 70,000 jobs by year-end.
- Currently, 10 out of 11 sectors show over-the-year growth led by Private Education and Health Services, Government, and Other Services.
