OCTOBER Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 148,237 people looking for a job
- **DOWN** from a peak of 13.5% in April 2020
- **DOWN** from 4.4% last month
- **UP** from 3.9% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 3.8%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 3.6%

Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston region added 16,400 jobs over the month consistent with October each year.

- The top-3 drivers of over-the-month Job increases this September were:
 - Government +6,400
 - Trade, Transportation, and Utilities +6,300
 - Private Education and Health Services +5900

Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was up 76,600 jobs or 2.3%

- A year prior, growth stood at 161,300; growth is expected to continue slowing to pre-pandemic levels of 60,000 to 70,000 jobs by year-end.
- Currently, 9 out of 11 sectors show over-the-year growth led by Private Education and Health Services, Trade, Transportation, and Utilities, and Government.
