DECEMBER Regional Unemployment Rate (not seasonally adjusted)

- Represents 140,487 people looking for a **new job**
- DOWN from a peak of 14.2% in April 2020
- **DOWN** by 0.1% from last month
- **DOWN** from 4.8% from last year
- **HIGHER** than the statewide rate of 3.6%
- **HIGHER** than the national rate of 3.3%

Monthly Change – Employers in the Houston-Galveston region ADDED 16,000 net jobs in December 2022

- Top-3 Drivers of month-to-month Job Growth in December:
 - Trade, Transportation & Utilities (includes retail and warehousing) +6,100
 - Leisure & Hospitality +3,700
 - Financial Activities +1,600

Year-over-Year Change – Total Nonfarm employment was UP 5.6%

- This represents 179,000 more jobs compared to this period last year
- Currently, 10 of 11 sectors show year-to-year growth

COVID-19

• Total Non-farm employment exceeds pre-pandemic levels, meaning that the Houston Gulf Coast region is now home to 3,356,000 jobs.
