Fort Bend County is located in East Central Texas and is one of 13 counties in the Gulf Coast Region. Fort Bend County's 2018 population estimate was 739,342. Richmond is the county seat. Other towns include Rosenberg, Katy, Sugar Land, Stafford and Missouri City. The Manufacturing, Trade, Service, Local Government and Construction Sectors fuel county employment. Fort Bend County is home of the Brazos Bend State Park covering over 4,800 acres. The average unemployment rate in Fort Bend County for 2019 was 3.5 percent.

\$57,540 ranking 24th in the State and was 114 percent of the State average, \$50,355. The compound annual growth rate over the past 10 years was 1.6 percent as compared to 2.5 percent for the State and 2.9 percent for the nation.




