

Montgomery County Profile

Montgomery County is located in East Central Texas and is one of 13 counties in the Gulf Coast Region. Montgomery County's 2013 population estimate was 499,137. Conroe is the county seat. Other towns include The Woodlands, Montgomery and New Caney. The Trade, Services, Manufacturing and Local Government Sectors fuel county employment. Montgomery County is home to Lake Conroe, a popular recreation area for Houston residents that are less than an hour away. The average unemployment rate in Montgomery County for 2013 was 5.4 percent.

Per Capita Personal Income (2012)

\$50,796 ranking 26th in the State and was 119 percent of the State average, \$42,638. The compound annual growth rate over the past 10 years was 4.6 percent as compared to 3.8 percent for the State and 3.2 percent for the nation.

Total Personal Income (2012)

\$24,638,680,000 ranking 10th in the State with a compound annual growth rate over the past 10 years of 8.8 percent as compared to 5.7 percent for the State and 4.1 percent for the nation.




