Nearly 170,000 gallons of bunker fuel spilled in Galveston Bay when a ship collided with a barge on March 22, 2014. The weather conditions have improved enabling cleaning operations and assessment activities to progress.

## Jobs Created by the Oil Spill

As many as 800 temporary jobs are available in response to the oil spill in Galveston Bay

- Hydro-blasters
  - \$10 \$15 per hour, up to \$18 per hour with proper certification
- General Laborers
  - \$10 \$15 per hour, up to \$18 per hour with proper certification

 The energy sector accounts for 3.4% of Houston's employment, more than five times the national average of 0.6%.

- Cooks, on land and off-shore\$200 per day

Potential workers need to have a Hazardous Waste Operation and Emergency Response Certification.
